1. Confirmation and Approval of the Minutes of the Academic Council Meeting held on 15 April 2026.

The Academic Council Meeting was held on 15th April 2026 to deliberate on various academic and institutional development matters. The resolutions and recommendations approved by the Academic Council were subsequently placed before the Governing Body and were duly ratified during its meeting held on 23rd April 2026.

2. Information on College Accreditations

i. Autonomous Status

► UGC has give Autonomous Status for 10 years, i.e., up to A.Y: 2032-33 and the same is conferred by JNTUK Kakinada.

* It was observed that the MBA V23 Regulations prescribe a **total of 102 credits**, comprising **30 credits in I sem**, However, the corresponding JNTUK Regulations prescribe a **total of 104 credits, with 32 credits in I sem**, due to this credit discrepancy, the final results of the MBA students admitted during the 2023 and 2024 batches could not be processed and published.

The Academic Council discussed the issue and recommended that the matter be placed before the Governing Body. It was resolved to seek the approval of the Governing Body and The Registrar, JNTUK for taking the necessary corrective action to resolve the issue and facilitate the publication of the results.

4. Review of Research Publications, Faculty Development Programmes, Workshops, and Student Activities

The Chairman presented a department-wise report on research paper publications, Faculty Development Programmes (FDPs), workshops organized, and workshops attended by both faculty members and students during the academic year.

Decision:

The Academic Council appreciated the efforts of all departments in promoting research and professional development activities. The Council particularly emphasized the need to enhance the quality and impact of research publications. Dr. M.H.M. Krishna Prasad and Dr. K.V.S.G. Murali Krishna advised the faculty members to focus on publishing research papers in reputed high-impact journals indexed in Scopus, SCI, and SCIE databases, and to increase patent filing and grant activities.
