The Chairman presented the agenda of the meeting, and the members deliberated on the following agenda items.

1. Discussion on the Academic Performance of Students for the Academic Year 2024–2025 (Odd Semester) – Result Analysis

The Chairman presented the detailed academic performance report of the students for the **Academic Year 2024–2025 (Odd Semester)**. The Board reviewed the examination results and analyzed the overall pass percentage, subject-wise performance, and student outcomes for the following examinations:

- II-I B.Tech Regular Examination
- I-I B.Tech Regular Examination
- I-II B.Tech Supplementary Examination
- I-I B.Tech Supplementary Examination

The result analysis included overall pass percentages, department-wise performance, subject-wise analysis, and identification of courses requiring academic intervention. The Chairman highlighted the strengths observed in student performance and the areas requiring improvement.

Decision

The Board of Studies reviewed the academic performance and appreciated the efforts of the faculty members. The members suggested the following measures to improve student performance:

- Conduct remedial classes for academically weaker students.
- Organize tutorial sessions before Semester End Examinations.
- Strengthen the faculty mentoring system.
- Increase continuous assessment and student counselling.
- Encourage students to participate in certification courses and technical activities to improve their knowledge and employability.

The Board unanimously approved the recommendations.

- Suggested continuous monitoring of slow learners through faculty mentoring.

- Suggested organizing additional remedial coaching for difficult subjects.

Dr. V. Krishna Reddy

- Advised strengthening problem-solving skills through coding practice and laboratory-based learning.
- Encouraged implementation of Outcome-Based Education (OBE) practices for continuous improvement.

Mr. N. Gangadhar (Industry Representative)

- Suggested improving communication skills, aptitude, and programming skills through value-added training programs.
- Encouraged students to participate in internships, hackathons, coding competitions, and industry certification programs.

Resolution
