Agenda 1: Discussion and Approval of Syllabi of B.Tech CSE & CSE (Data Science) - I & II Semesters and M.Tech CSE

The BoS Chair Person presented the details related to the course structure and syllabus. Decision: Noted and approved the course structure, syllabus, and Course Outcome (CO) specifications.

- B.Tech CSE & CSE (DS) (I & II Semesters): Approved with minor modifications in syllabus contents and Course Outcomes.
- M.Tech CSE Course Structure: Updated the curriculum by including the new syllabus recently designed for JNTUK UCEK(A).

Agenda 2: Implementation of Teaching Learning Process

The BoS Members appreciated the department faculty for effectively utilizing ICT facilities in the implementation of the Teaching Learning Process. Decision: Noted and appreciated the faculty for successfully completing NPTEL courses in emerging areas.

Agenda 3: Information on Proposed Calendar of Events for A.Y. 2026-27

The BoS Chair Person informed the members about the proposed calendar of events organized for students for the Academic Year 2026-27.

Detailed Suggestions Given by the BoS Members Dr.

R. B. V. Subramanyam (External Member)

- Suggested modifying verbs in a few Course Outcomes to use 'develop' instead of 'implement' and 'devise'.
- Incorporate a detailed syllabus covering String Processing in the Programming course during the first semester.
- Include the Forouzan textbook as a prescribed textbook for the Programming course and move the current list of textbooks to the references section.
- Merge Units 1 to 4 and re-distribute them into the first three units. Unit 4 should cover the

- Introduction to Trees, Binary Trees, BST, AVL Trees, Heap Trees, and Heap Sort.
- Unit 5 should focus on the Introduction to Graphs, Graph Traversals, Topological Sort, Biconnected Components, and Hashing.
 - Make lab tasks generic rather than specific across all laboratories (C Programming, Data Structures, and IT Workshop).
 - Update the M.Tech syllabus in alignment with the recent updates in UCEK.

Dr. A. Krishna Mohan (University Nominee)

- Cross-check the marks allocation for Continuous Internal Assessment (CIA) and Semester End Examinations (SEE) for Audit courses.
- Suggested including the M.Tech CSE curriculum with R26 regulations.
- Prepare the overall Course Structure strictly in line with APSCHE guidelines.
- Expand the topic detail for 'File operations' in the 'Introduction to Programming' course.

Dr. M. Balaji (External Member)

- Improve and align the skill set of students to match modern industry demands and needs.
- Suggested optimizing the 'Introduction to Programming' course core concepts.

Mr. D. Rama Rao (Member - Industrialist)

- Emphasized the addition of project-based industry skill training modules.
- Suggested highlighting real-world agile methodology exposures inside advanced labs.

R. Ramya Sri (Member - Alumni)

- Suggested including practical interview-readiness code blocks in structure reviews.
